## The Church of the Holy Spirit – Update from the Senior Warden

On July 20, the vestry, officers, and Father Rushton gathered together for a mutual ministry review. This is an opportunity to reflect on what we have accomplished since we met last October as well as looking at future goals.

One of the goals we had previously established was to grow membership. We were successful in calling Father Rushton as our rector and felt we were in a position to grow and strengthen our membership. After a review of membership records, it was determined the official records did not accurately reflect our membership. A lot of work has been done to update the records so they are accurate. Forms were sent out to members to update their information. Members who have moved away, died, or who have not attended in years have been removed from the active membership and the records now reflect a more accurate picture of our membership. We have noticed attendance at both the 8am and 10am has increased over the past year and we have been blessed to have new individuals/families join our Church.

Moving forward, a goal we focused on was to strengthen opportunities for fellowship both within our own congregation as well as in the community. Currently, we participate in the Ocean Cluster in which the three Episcopal Churches in north Worcester County join together for outreach and fellowship. Examples of this include our picnics, Hope4Recovery, Annual Three Parish Pilgrimage, etc. We also want to focus on fellowship within and have discussed a variety of ideas including joining worship for both the 8am and 10am services several times a year so members can get to know each other, rotating potluck dinners throughout the year, "soup and study" beginning during Lent. Lastly, we want to increase opportunities to welcome the public into our Church as well as the use of our Church Hall. Recent examples include the Chinese Church Community for J-1 students, condo meetings, Agape retreat, and fundraisers. We will be planning a family night during Winter break and explore opportunities for activities in the Church Hall.


