From the Rector

My Dear Church of the Holy Spirit Family,



We have now completed our eighth weekend with Sunday Services of Holy Eucharist at 8am and 10am inside church property. We have been conducting services, one in the Nave (main body) of the church and the other in the parish hall. Both areas for worship have been clearly marked indicating seating that is at minimum six feet away from others.

Our parishioners and guests have been wonderful in accepting the conditions for attendance and the changes in our worship experience. We have made adjustments for receiving Holy Communion – all intended to safely minimize movement from our seats as we maintain a prayerful and hospitable experience.

Those attending on Sunday have expressed gratitude for being back inside the church. We are sharing in a way that the 8am and 10am services are alternately conducted in the parish hall and the main church. There is additional space to safely accommodate more attendees at either service.

The reopening of the church requires both in-person services as well as an online presence. We have corrected technical difficulties that had prevented us from delivering what we hope will be typical Sunday standard. We have invested in additional technology and devices that will allow us to consistently record our services, which will be made available on YouTube.

In addition, we will "Live Stream" (with a few seconds delay) to celebrate Sunday at the Church of the Holy Spirit from your home.

The Church of the Holy Spirit – The Ocean Cluster of Episcopal Churches

CONFIRMATION

RECEPTION INTO THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH

REAFFIRMATION OF BAPTISMAL VOWS

In the course of their Christian development, those baptized at an early age are expected, when they are ready and have been duly prepared, to make a mature public affirmation of their faith and commitment to the responsibilities of their Baptism and to receive the laying on of hands by the bishop.

Those baptized as adults, unless baptized with laying on of hands by a bishop, are also expected to make a public affirmation of their faith and commitment to the responsibilities of their Baptism in the presence of a bishop and to receive the laying on of hands.

(From The Book of Common Prayer, Page 412)

In Baptism, we were marked with "sacred oil" Chrism and claimed as Christ's forever. For many in the Episcopal tradition, we were brought to the Church very young. Promises were made on our behalf. We started our faith-filled journey with the guidance of those who presented us for Baptism.

Now, years down the road, the gift to follow Jesus is there for us to claim!

This brings us to CONFIRMATION – RECEPTION INTO THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH – REAFFIRMATION OF BAPTISMAL VOWS. Each of these are similar processes. We now have the opportunity to come before the Bishop and make promises for ourselves to be blessed.

These sacramental activities are celebrations within the Church community. Individuals proclaim their belief in God and the desire to recommit their lives to a faith-filled life.

Religious education is undertaken prior to the ceremony.

Classes will begin in September (via Zoom) and continue for a period of eight weeks. Bishop Santosh Marray's visit to the Church of the Holy Spirit will be in November 2020.
