From the Rector

My Dear Church of the Holy Spirit Family,

As I write to you, Ocean City is experiencing a mild fall with daytime approaching 70 degrees and evenings approaching 60 degrees. The fall season has begun. Vacationers are fewer and the motorcycle and automobile gatherings are finished until next spring. I believe we are in for quiet evenings in the upcoming months.

Our parish season is beginning to be more active. On November 1, 2020 we will celebrate All Saints Sunday. We will remember, honor and thank God for the continued care of our loved ones who have died. At both Sunday services we will commemorate their passing from this earthly life to eternal life and ritually light candles in their honor.

Separate communications with parents will be initiated in the coming weeks.

I continue to keep our parish family in my prayerful moments and keep you in my thoughts. May we continue to be cautious in our activities, safe in our comings and goings, generous in our communications with one another and attentive to our brothers and sisters in their needs. May we continue to seek support for ourselves and to be a support to others.


