#### The Ocean Cluster - Update!

The Ocean Cluster is comprised of the three Episcopal churches in the local area, Church of the Holy Spirit (north Ocean City), St. Paul's by-the-Sea (south Ocean City) and St. Paul's (Berlin). The Ocean Cluster organizes events among our three churches and works together providing outreach to those in need.

The Ocean Cluster continues to support Hope4Recovery located in Berlin. Hope4Recovery is a treatment center for men recovering from addictions. The group prepares and delivers dinner one Sunday every month. The Church of the Holy Spirit will provide the main dish and sides for the meal on Sunday, April 16.

The Ocean Cluster will fill Easter Baskets (or bags if there are too many items!) for the residents of Hope4Recovery. The group will be collecting donations of large and extra large tee-shirts, toiletries (no liquids), and candy. Socks are not needed as there was a surplus from the last collection. Volunteers will fill 15 bags, one for each of the 11 residents. The extras will be welcome gifts for anyone moving into Hope4Recovery as they often arrive with nothing. If you prefer to provide items for the house, suggestions include games, adult coloring books, colored pencils, playing cards, and similar items. Monetary gifts are always welcome to purchase items for the baskets. All donations should be placed in the bins at the back of the church by Palm Sunday, April 2.

The next committee meeting of the Ocean Cluster is at the Church of the Holy Spirit on Thursday, May 4 at 2:00pm. All are welcome!
