From the Rector

Dear Church of the Holy Spirit Family:

I wish to express my thanks to all the members of our church family including those who gather with us weekly, join us when they are in town, or connect to our worship services by way of Zoom, YouTube, and Facebook. Many individuals contribute to our weekly celebrations: our church secretary, altar guild, musicians, guest pianist, readers, ministers of communion, greeters, ushers, and those who prepare refreshments for our fellowship gathering following the Sunday service. Many others donate to purchase the flowers which grace our sanctuary and especially at our Easter services. Everyone mentioned above loves and serves the church.

One additional ministry to spotlight is the care and education of our children at Sunday School. The wonderful Easter Egg hunt delighted those who searched for eggs. Smiles and joy were experienced by all. Thanks be to God for the love and service offered by Kathy Elmer and Caleb Elmer. The Sunday School year ends on May 7 with the presentation of Sunday School pins acknowledging the faithful commitment of our students to their Religious Education.

Our worship continues. We are amid the seven-week Easter Season. Our gospel lessons have moved from the Evangelist Luke to the Evangelist John.

In last week's Gospel reading, Jesus speaks regarding Himself. So again Jesus said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and bandits; but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved and will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly." (John 10: 7-10)

The next three Sunday gospel readings will recount earlier periods of ministry of our Savior. Jesus will explain that He has come to teach about the Father who created us. Jesus was sent to be among us. The Father has entrusted our care to Jesus, the anointed Messiah of God. Jesus instructs his disciples that He will not always be with them. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit of God will continue to teach them and remind them of their time with Jesus.

On the last Sunday of Easter, the Gospel will call to mind Jesus' prayer to the Father on our behalf.

Jesus looked up to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son so that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him authority over all people, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. And this is eternal life, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. I glorified you on earth by finishing the work that you gave me to do. So now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had in your presence before the world existed." (John 17: 1-5)

On the Sunday of Memorial Day weekend (May 28), we will celebrate Pentecost. The Holy Spirit appears and is received by the Apostles. This emboldens them to leave their home and proclaim Jesus as the Risen Lord and the Anointed of God. The message moves beyond the small group of believers. The Church has its beginning.

I wish you a safe and happy end of Spring and the commencement of Summer in Ocean City. Let us go forth in peace to love and serve our creator and all of God's creation. Hope to see you at Church!

The Ocean Cluster continues to support Hope4Recovery located in Berlin. Hope4Recovery is a treatment center for men recovering from addictions. The group prepares and delivers dinner one Sunday every month. The Church of the Holy Spirit will provide the bread and salads for the meal on Sunday, May 21.

Once again, the Ocean Cluster filled Easter bags for the residents of the Hope4Recovery House. This has become an annual event, and the residents are thrilled. This year we included T-shirts, toothbrushes and toothpaste and lots and lots of candy. We also filled a couple of bags with items for the House, such as playing cards and games. Many thanks to everyone that donated items for the bags, we could not have done it without you!

We continue to take dinner to the House monthly and at last are able to stay and share the meal with the residents. Conversation flows as food is enjoyed. It's a positive experience for all of us.
