155TH ANNUAL CONVENTION

Earlier this year the Diocese of Easton held its 155th Annual Convention. The Church of the Holy Spirit had two parish members serve as representatives at the convention, **Tyler Betz and Monica Martin**.

The convention is the annual forum where all 40+ worship communities that make up the Episcopal Diocese of Easton come together to worship, debate, and govern.

Notable happenings at the convention include Bishop Marray's annual address to the diocese, the passage of a new constitution, business reports, and appointment to various Diocesan committees and departments. The bishop's address was especially inspirational. Reach out to me for link to the text, if interested. The title was "The Call to be a Prophetic Church," and one passage from the remarks that stood out to me was "My beloved, at this the 155th Diocesan Convention, we have come to pilgrimage together in the new light. This new narrative is what is shining in the darkness. Jesus lives in this 'little gem,' the churches of the Diocese of Easton on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. Jesus has granted us permission to change us for the good."

There was an invited speaker at the convention, Melisaa Rau. Her address to the convention discussed how the church may adapt and change to suit the spiritual needs of today's youth. The address challenged the attendees, and the church as a whole, to conduct ongoing discussion and critical self-examination to consider how the contemporary church has evolved over the years, and how it may continue to evolve and adapt to the needs of youth and young adults.

All members of COHS may participate in the governance of the parish, and of the diocese. There are many opportunities for members to share their talents, passions, and time to help our church grow and thrive. Of course, the number one way to serve is by being present in and with the worship community. See everyone on Sunday! **Yours, Tyler**

CHURCH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT OUARTER AUCTION

The quarter auction, one of our big fund-raisers, will be held on **August 7** in the parish hall. The **doors will open at 6 p.m.** so you can look at the prizes and purchase something to eat, and the **games begin at 7**. **Tickets are \$10** and **include one bidding paddle**.
